The range of services includes: individual, couple and family therapy, parent education/support in the community. The clinician will provide individual, group, and family therapy as needed.

An Associate Therapist must perform all essential job functions and duties required by One Life Counseling Center, and adhere to all mental health legal and ethical mandates and guidelines as outlined by the American Association of Marriage and Family Therapists or National Association of Social Workers.

The job duties for an Associate Therapist may include, but are not limited to, providing crisis intervention, family support, parent education, safety planning, and intake assessment for families and their children. The Associate Therapist will be required to maintain timely and clinically appropriate documentation of all clinical services, attend program meetings; participate in: didactic training and other mandatory training, clinical supervision, , clinical staff and service quality meetings. In the execution of duties, other responsibilities include timely completion of charting, billing, report preparation, and ethical/confidentiality issues.
